## HIGH PLAINS REGIONAL RENDEZVOUS

June 19 - 26, 2010

In the beautiful and historical  
Black Hills of South Dakota



The 2010 HPRR is located in Hughes Draw near  
Flag Mountain, Northwest of Deerfield Lake in the  
Central Black Hills of South Dakota.

The High Plains Regional Rendezvous is a pre-1840  
Rendezvous. All camps, accoutrements, clothing and  
trade goods are required to be representative of those  
prior to the 1840 Fur Trade Era.

Loading and unloading after 8:00 am June 19 until after  
Closing Ceremonies June 26 is limited to one hour.

Rendezvous participants must wear primitive clothing to enter, occupy  
and leave camp from June 19 until after Closing Ceremonies June 26.  
This includes proper footwear for participants of all ages.

Trade Tokens will be awarded for Rendezvous Events. All 2010 HPRR  
tokens will need to be redeemed at the 2010 Rendezvous.

The HPRR site is set in the ponderosa pines of the Black Hills National Forest. Elevation is approximately  
6400 feet so weather can vary considerably. Expect warm days and cool nights but be prepared for any and all  
variations in weather.

Numerous historical and family attractions are located in or near the Black Hills. We encourage you to take  
advantage of these many attractions by coming to the Black Hills area early or stay later. Or, if you must,  
sneak away during Rendezvous to see such things as Mt. Rushmore, Crazy Horse and Custer State Park as  
well as numerous other sights and attractions.

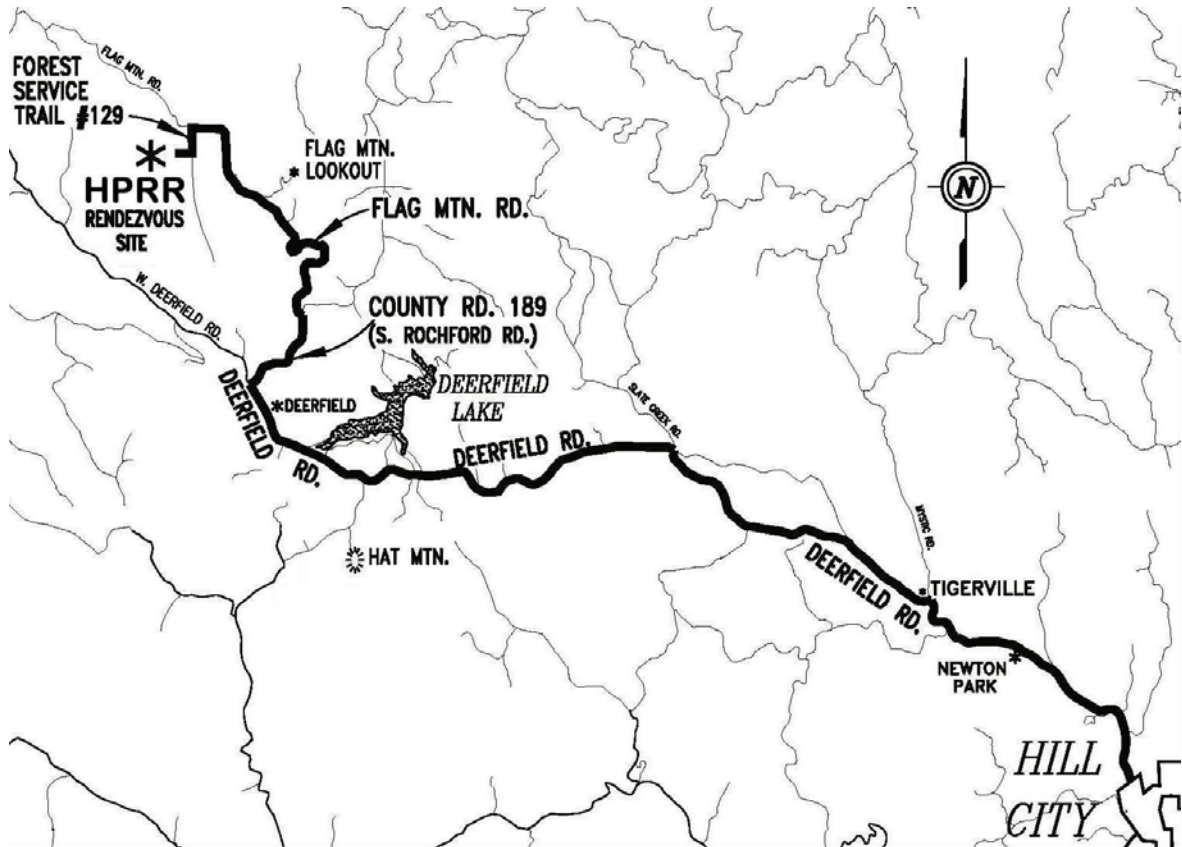
\* Traders will be assessed a 5% surcharge by the US Forest Service on reported sales.

**DIRECTIONS:** Take Highway 16 to Hill City  
 Then WEST on Deerfield Road for 19.2 miles  
 Then NORTH on COUNTY RD 189 (S. ROCHFORD RD.)  
 Then NORTHWEST on FLAG MOUNTAIN RD for 5.9 miles  
 Then South on TRAIL #129 about 1/2 mile to parking area.
